

Christmas Mystery 2008

Here comes the first part of the Christmas Mystery. Yo-Ho! from Merete Veian :: part 1
Did you bring your sewing machine?

Bring out the 3" green strip, - 3" x ca 11"

You will also need these light background strips:

- 1 strip 1 ¼" x ca 11"

- 1 strip 1,5" x ca 13"

Block A:

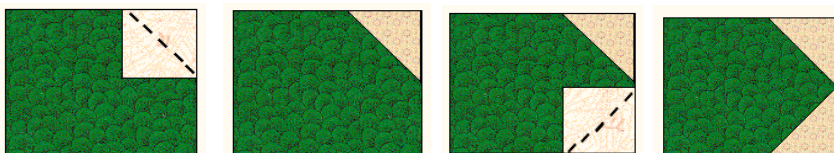
Cut 4 green rectangles 2,5" x 3"

Cut 8 light background squares 1 ¼" x 1 ¼"

Cut 8 light background squares 1,5" x 1,5"

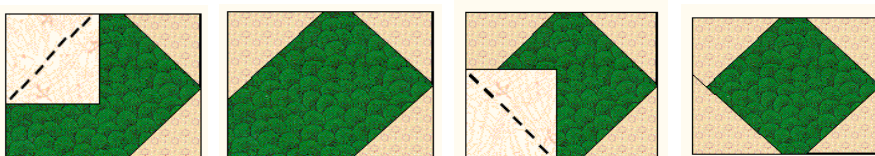
Sew block A like this:

Use 1 green rectangle and 2 light background squares 1 ¼" x 1 ¼"



1. Lay one of the light squares on the background patch, at top right corner.
2. Stitch it down diagonally across (from corner to corner).
3. Open up and press towards the corner.
4. Lay the other light square on the background patch, at bottom right corner.
5. Stitch it down diagonally across (from corner to corner).
6. Open up and press towards the corner.

Now use 2 light background squares 1,5" x 1,5"



1. Lay one of the light squares on the background patch, at top left corner.
2. Stitch it down diagonally across (from corner to corner).
3. Open up and press towards the corner.
4. Lay the other light square on the background patch, at bottom left corner.
5. Stitch it down diagonally across (from corner to corner).
6. Open up and press towards the corner.

To get one block, cut and sew a total of 4 of block A:

Get out 3 more green rectangles 2,5" x 3", 6 light background squares 1 ¼" x 1 ¼" and 6 light background squares 1,5" x 1,5".

Then put together and sew block A as described above, 3 times more.

To get 4 tablemats, cut and sew a total of 16 of block A.
